Is an international Stage-director from the Netherlands. He has created Plays, Opera's, Musicals and Operetta's in Germany, Belgium, Ukraine, and Bulgaria.

His work as an director was proceeded by an extensive acting career. He studied in New York with Stella Adler and appeared a myriad of parts for television, theatre and opera and was a long standing member of the (in)famous 'Werkteater'. There he was both actor and director and responsible for the creation of more than thirty productions. From the mid 90's on he focused on musical-theatre and starred in several big productions.

He has taught drama and interpretation at the Fontys school of Arts in Tilburg the Conservatory of Amsterdam and is currently working for the Dutch National Opera.
